

CAZINSKI MED OD KESTENA

This GI serves to distinguish special type of honey from Cazin region in the North West of Bosnia and Herzegovina.

This type of honey is produced with the use of both modern and traditional methods of beekeeping in the area of 2500 hectares of chestnut forest. Main characteristic of this type of honey is purity in terms of pollen grains that is larger than 85%. The reason for this is the fact that at the time of flowering of chestnut (*Aesculus hippocastanum*) no other species of honey plants are in bloom.
