1. Revision of the Lisbon Agreement

- Refinement and Modernization of the Legal Framework
- Accession Possibility for Intergovernmental Organizations (e.g., EU, OAPI)

2. Specify the Applicability of the Lisbon System to AO and other GI

- Attract New Members
- Increase the Number of International Registrations
- Preserve and Build on the Principles and Objectives of the Lisbon Agreement



Subject-Matter of Protection (GIs and AOs)

Indication of a Connection between Characteristics of Products and their Geographical Origin

- Informs consumers of the uniqueness of the products derived from this connection (typicality)
- Represents the collective goodwill derived from this uniqueness (reputation)
- Value-added

Draft Revised Lisbon Agreement Main Provisions

- Subject-matter; Geographical areas of origin
- Procedures and Fees (application, registration, refusal, renunciation, modification, invalidation)
- Content of Protection
- Prior rights and Prior use
- Accession criteria for Intergovernmental Organizations (e.g., EU, OAPI)



- Definitions
 - ✓ direct or indirect reference to a geographical area
- > AO or GI of a trans-border geographical area



Treaty will apply to Denominations and Indications Protected in the Contracting Party of Origin

AO

- Protected Denomination
- Known as Referring to a Geographical Area
- Designating a Good as Originating Therein
- Quality or Characteristics
- Reputation
- Due to the Geographical Environment (Natural Factors/ Human Factors)

GI

- Protected Indication
- Known as Referring to a Geographical Area
- Identifying a Good as Originating Therein
- Quality, Reputation or Other Characteristic
- Attributable to its Geographical Origin



- Procedures
 - filing of applications by right holders
- > Fees



Effect of international registration

- Lisbon: extension of protection to other Lisbon members (one fee)
- Madrid: extension of protection to other Madrid members, as designated (fees)
- Lisbon: indefinite (in principle)
- Madrid: renewable every 10 years (fees)
- Revised Lisbon: individual and renewal fees?

Except in a member that ...

- issued a refusal (within the prescribed time-limit), or
- invalidated the effect of the international registration in its territory
 - Revised Lisbon: limitation grounds for invalidation?



Grounds of refusal under Lisbon

- □ Any member has the right to refuse protection on its territory
- □ Refusals can be based on "any situation of fact or law that would prevent the grant of protection on the whole or part of the territory of the Lisbon Union"

- Content of protection
 - ✓ form and terminology may not be used to deny protection, if substantive criteria definition met



Terminology

- Distinctive Signs for Individual Use
 - Trademarks (goods & services)

- Distinctive Signs for Collective Use
 - Collective marks
 - Certification marks
 - Geographical indications
 - Appellations of origin
 - Indications of source



Existing Means of Protection

- Laws Focusing on Business Practices
- Sui Generis Legislation
 - concerning specifically defined characteristics of the product or methods of their production
- Trademark Law
- Other Special Protection



- Protection against use in respect of goods of the same kind as those to which the AO or GI applies
 - ✓ not originating in the geographical area of origin or not complying with any other applicable requirements
 - ✓ even if the AO or GI used with minor differences, etc.
- Various proposals for a reputation-based protection
- Safeguards for prior trademarks and some other rights
- Revised Lisbon: phasing-out prior use that is not used as a ground for refusal, unless the use is covered by a safeguarded right?
