

Khalkh Gol Honey

Khalkh gol honey was registered in the name of khalkh gol honey association NGO, registration date: **2013.02.18**, registration number: **11183**, application number: **12474**

The area along Khalkha River is home to honey plants that are enough for about two million hives of bees to collect nectar, according to the beekeepers. Mongolia has the potential to meet its domestic honey demand and even export quality honey, according to the beekeeper of 34 years.



Khalkhgol's honey originated in the Khalkhgol territory of the Dornod province; this ecological, pure organic product has been produced by local people and distributed at the market. Nowadays, it has almost become more famous over Russian or imported honey.

The weather is appropriate to have bee farms in Khalkhgol territory; there almost 135 types of flowers and grasses, which are important for bees

and comprises 47.8 percent of honey's syrup.
